Blood tests to investigate recurrent miscarriage.

FBC	Haematology	Purple x1
Antinuclear antibodies	Immunology	Red x1
Acquired Thrombophilia: Antiphospholipid syndrome <ul style="list-style-type: none">Lupus anticoagulantAnticardiolipin antibodies (IgG and IgM)β2 glycoprotein I antibodies (IgG and IgM)	Haematology	Blue x 2 Red x 1
HBA1c To be considered if BMI >30, family history, history of gestational diabetes, high risk ethnicity, PCOS	Haematology	Purple x 1
